Meter"

Water Save Dave points to the supers happily

Water Save Dave continues:

Water Save Dave : Join the scheme

Description of visuals : The scene moves to the corridor outside the landlord's flat

A plumber just installed three separate water meters for the subdivided units for measuring the water

supplies to the units individually
The landlord and the plumber stand

in front of the separate water meters with a smile on their faces

They then glance at the separate water meters behind them

look and nod at each other in agreement. Water Save Dave says to the camera:

Water Save Dave : Install separate water meters

for subdivided unit tenants

Description of visuals : The shot turns to the tenants of the three subdivided units

The tenants face the camera happily with their hands holding the water bills from the Water Supplies Department

Young man says:

Young Man : With individual water bills

Description of visuals : The tenants of the three subdivided units

including the mother, the young man and the middle-aged man, say together:

Three tenants : Water charges are "pay-as-you-go"

Description of visuals : The shot turns to the landlord standing

in front of the separate water meters

He says happily:

Landlord : Water charges are now clear without disputes

Description of visuals : The shot turns to the mother and daughter's unit

with the super

"First 12 m³ of Water are Free at 4 Month Intervals"

appears on the screen

The mother is holding a glass of water

Mother says to the camera:

Mother : We can also enjoy a certain amount of free water

Description of visuals : At the same time

the daughter is drinking water beside her mother

She then puts down the water glass and smiles in front of the camera

Description of visuals : End frame shows Water Save Dave

appearing from the left of the screen

The slogan

"Don't Overcharge for Water Apply Now to Install Meters"

appears on the top of the screen

and the Water Supplies Department logo are shown at the bottom of the screen Water Save Dave appeals to the audience:
