Super: Saving virtual water

VO(Male): Virtual water is an invisible part of our daily water consumption and

we have overlooked it. Let me tell you what "Virtual Water" is.

Virtual water refers to the amount of water embedded in

commodities and particularly in food. If the commodities are

produced overseas, we are consuming water from another country.

To reduce virtual water consumption, we should make smart

choices when selecting food. For example, it requires 15400 litres of

water to produce 1 kilogram of beef.

Super: Produce 1 kilogram of beef = 15,400 litres of water

VO(Male): But it requires 4330 litres of water to produce the same weight of

chicken meat.

Super: Produce 1 kilogram chicken meat = 4,330 litres of water.

VO(Male): Producing beef consumes 3 times more water than producing

chicken.

Super: Beef > chicken meat

3 times more

VO(Male): See! Be aware of virtual water. If you make poor food choices,

you may become the culprit behind water wastage. Be aware of virtual water, make smart food choices
