Individual Consumers

serving their own premises, including the water pipes and fittings between their

individual meters and the communal service. To be responsible for the safe custody of

individual meters serving their own premises.

Registered Agent's Responsibility (e.g. Property Management Office)

To take custody of, maintain and repair* the communal service after the control valve

nearest to the main including the water mains and other associated water supply

facilities in the private streets and communal areas within private housing estates and

buildings (such as underground pipework within lot boundaries, water pumps, water

tanks, valves and others).

*You are suggested to employ a licensed plumber to maintain and repair the plumbing

facilities. For leakage detection of underground pipework, professional leakage

detection companies can be engaged.

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
