



**"Excursion with Water Save Dave" Visiting Programme
Guidance Note for Participants**

1. Points to note before the tour:

- Since the activity is carried out outdoors most of the time, participants should ensure that their health condition is good on the event day. If there is any discomfort, it is not recommended to participate in the activity.
- Participants are required to arrive at the gathering location on time. If it is necessary to change the gathering time and/or location or even cancel the scheduled tour due to unexpected circumstances, the Water Supplies Department will notify the participants by telephone as soon as practicable.
- The visiting session in morning will be cancelled without any notice if Amber Rainstorm Warning Signal or above, or Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above is in force at or after 7:00 am on the date of visit. The visiting session in the afternoon will be cancelled without any notice if the aforementioned signal is in force at or after 11:30 am on the date of visit.

2. Suggested participants' equipment:

- Suitable hiking clothes and comfortable thick socks (For example, light, quick-drying and breathing long-sleeve trousers)
- Lightweight backpack
- Windbreaker, jacket and warm clothing
- Hiking Shoes
- Hiking Pole (There are slopes and steps during the tour)
- Anti-mosquito and sunscreen products (For example, mosquito-repellent, sun hat, sunblock)
- Umbrella or raincoat
- Towel
- Water (Recommend to bring at least 1 liter per person)
- Food
- Personal medicine (if necessary)
- Extra clothes for replacing

3. Points to note during the tour:

- Please follow the instructions of tour guides during the tour to avoid danger.
- Please do not leave the tour without notification.
- Participants should pay attention to the own safety and take care of the personal belongings. The Water Supplies Department will not be responsible for any loss or damages.
- Please do not feed the monkeys or wild animals during the tour.
- The itinerary of the tour may be subject to change due to the weather condition, site condition or other unexpected circumstances. For safety reasons, the Water Supplies Department reserves the rights to change the itinerary, shorten or terminate the tour immediately.
