

“eWater” mobile app

- Super : New mobile app “eWater” has been launched
- Man : Why do I receive a payment reminder and a disconnection notice?
- Woman : I meant to go to the convenience store to pay the bill the other day but I forgot to bring the notice
Then it slipped my mind
- Man : You’re so forgetful
You should download the new WSD mobile app “eWater”
- Super : eWater
- Man VO : If you have applied for the e-Bill service, you can log in to “eWater” anytime and anywhere to view your water bills from the past two years
- Super : The latest water bill/previous water bills from the past two years
- Man VO : If you forget to pay,
- Super : Push notification will be sent three days before due date
- Man VO : the system will send a reminder three days before due date
- Super : Pay Now →
- Man VO : Just click “Pay Now” and you can link to Faster Payment System for direct payment
- Super : Faster Payment System

Man VO : or download the QR code to pay at the convenience store

Super : Download the QR code to pay at the convenience store

Woman : For our newly rented unit, we need to apply for taking up
of water account
I'll check how to apply later

Man : It can be done with “eWater”

Man VO : “eWater” allows you to manage account-related
applications in one go, such as applying for taking up of
water account, closing of water account and refund of
water deposit, applying for e-Bill service, and updating
personal particulars

Super : Manage account-related applications in one go

Apply for taking up of water account
Apply for closing of water account and refund of water
deposit
Apply for e-Bill service
Update personal particulars

Woman : But I have to remember another app password
I definitely won't remember it

Man : Haven't you installed “iAM Smart”?

Man VO : “iAM Smart” users can log in to “eWater” without
entering the password again

Super : iAM Smart
Log in “eWater” account with “iAM Smart”

- Man VO : or you can enable biometric authentication function in “eWater”, so you can log in easily
- Woman : Last night, there was no water supply at home
I called the management office but no one answered
Is it a water suspension?
- Man : I didn’t receive any water suspension notifications on “eWater” last night
- Man VO : If you install “eWater” and select the concerned districts or housing estates, you will receive push notifications once there is a water suspension
- Super : Subscribe to specific districts or housing estates to receive water suspension notifications
- Man VO : You can also check the estimated time for water resumption
- Super : Estimated time for water resumption
- Man VO : If you follow a specific water suspension case, you can choose to be notified immediately of any updates
- Woman : Why don’t we introduce Mr. Chan from the management office to use “eWater”?
That way, he won’t be overwhelmed by residents’ questions
- Man : Good idea
- Man VO : “eWater” is particularly useful for property management work or related professionals
For instance, you can download water suspension notices and post them in prominent locations,

Super : Temporary water suspension notices available for download

Man VO : and directly forward the notices to relevant personnel via messaging apps, like sending them to the building's resident group

Woman : Actually, last night wasn't a water suspension
The faucet was not working
I forgot to tell you

Man : It's okay
I'll go buy a new faucet later
We can also check "eWater" for nearby registered General Acceptance (GA) product shop to confirm which ones are authorized models

Super : Search for registered GA product shop

Man and Woman : Download "eWater" now and enjoy smart living
